1. Promotion and Dissemination of Islamic Arts

- Education and Awareness: To understand the rich historical and cultural context of Islamic arts, to teach local and international audiences how deep and diversified these arts are. To create knowledge and awareness for visitors about the aesthetic values, historical origins and philosophical foundations of Islamic arts.
- Inspiring Young Artists: To support young artists and inspire new artistic productions by encouraging the sharing of knowledge and experience. To show young artists how they can benefit from the tradition of Islamic arts.

• Trade and Cooperation: The fair aims to establish a cooperation network between institutions such as art galleries, museums, universities and art schools. Furthermore, it is one of our goals to increase trade opportunities between designers and artists, to establish partnerships for products and projects



SECTIONS OF THE FAIR

Art Exhibitions: A large collection of traditional and contemporary works.

Installation Works: Interactive artworks with the theme of the Tree of Life and the verses of Creation.

Practical Workshops: Sections where art lovers can experience arts such as calligraphy, marbling, gilding in the company of master artists.

Conferences, Panels and Interviews: Sessions with academicians and artists who are experts in the field of Islamic arts.

Art and Culture Publications: Book and writing works section, where rare works of Islamic art are exhibited.

Digital Approaches and Installations: The section of installation art, which can be exhibited through original materials and disciplines together with artificial intelligence-supported digital art works.

Music Events: A section consisting of concerts and concerts that reflect the cultural and artistic richness of Islamic arts, where music in various forms will take place in different regions of the Islamic world.

The music events at the Islamic Arts Fair aim to combine both traditional music and contemporary interpretations and offer participants a cultural discovery through music.

All participating artists' names along with the artist's artwork images must be sent to the Selection Committee for submission, otherwise the gallery, artists and works that have not been approved by the Selection Committee will not be able to participate in the fair The minimum rentable stand area is 18 m2. A minimum of 5 m area will be allocated for each artist. The wall can be allocated.

> • The art pieces whose height is greater than 60 cm will not be hung in a column order. If 2 pictures smaller than 60 cm in height are hung on the boards in a row, it is mandatory to hang a single picture on the side boards.

The exhibition of large-sized and new art works is the reason of preference; however, there are no restrictions on the size of the work. There should be a minimum distance of 40 cm between the exhibited works. The fair management reserves the right to intervene in exhibitions

that violate the rules.
